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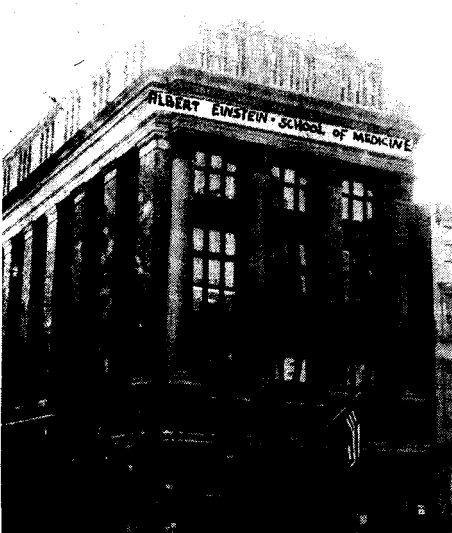

Brooklyn Travelogue Found in City Dump

Recently discovered in a Brooklyn sanitation depot by an enterprising collector of trash were the voluminous travelogues of Sandler of Tudela (1473-1964).
