




JewishGen TALKS

BELFER GRADUATE SCHOOL OF SCIENCE DISSERTATIONS ADDED TO YAIR

A collaboration of two library departments, Metadata Services & Processing and Web & Digital Services, have launched a collaborative project to digitize doctoral dissertations from the Belfer Graduate School of Science (1958-1978). Leon E. Gerber's 1969 dissertation, Asymptotic Relations between Differential and Difference Equations, was the first completed. The dissertation has open access and is discoverable via a Google search.
