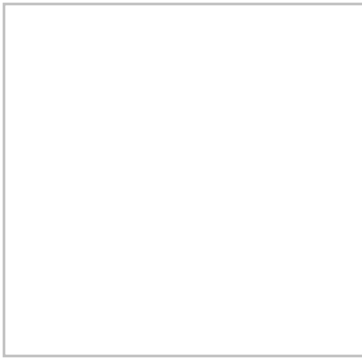
ALUMNAE PUBLICATIONS ON VIEW
